unwrapping Your Gift

OVERVIEW:

Spiritual gifts are not meant to stay hidden or wrapped up in insecurity. They are designed to be unwrapped, understood, and used for God's glory. In this second lesson, students will learn how to discover and develop their spiritual gifts with confidence and faith. We'll explore how God reveals His gifts and how to respond to His call.

Scripture Passage:

Romans 12:6–8 (KJV)

Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith; Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching; Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness.

EDUCATE

Point 1: Recognize the gift.

The first step in discovering your spiritual gift is believing that you actually have one. It may not feel supernatural at first—God often reveals gifts through passions, burdens, or consistent patterns in how we serve. However, as we pray about the areas where we have interests and talents, we may soon realize that God has placed a gift within us.

What are some things you naturally enjoy doing when it comes to serving God or helping others?

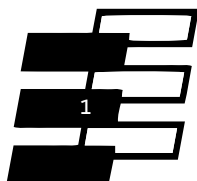
Point 2: Pray it out and try it out.

You won't find your gift by sitting still. Prayer and action go hand in hand. If you want to know what God has placed in you, get around His presence and His people—and serve.

Why do you think some people hesitate to try something new in church or ministry?

Point 3: Feedback is fuel.

God often speaks through others. Trusted leaders, mentors, or friends in church might recognize a gift in you before you see it yourself. Don't fear feedback—embrace it.



Has someone ever pointed out something in you that you didn't realize was a strength or gift? What happened after?

Closing

This week, pray this each morning: "God, help me see the gifts You've placed in me. I want to grow, serve, and be used for Your glory."

ENGAGE

Choose one new way to serve. It might be helping at the altar, greeting others, encouraging a friend, or supporting behind the scenes. Also ask a trusted leader or mentor, "What do you see in me spiritually?" Let God speak through them. Your gift won't grow by accident—it grows by action.
